<u>PREHEARING MEMORANDUM</u> <u>OF CITIZEN POWER, INC.</u>

Pursuant to the Public Utility Code, 52 Pa. Code § 5.222(d)(1), and in response to the May 24, 2010 Administrative Law Judges' Prehearing Conference Order in the above-captioned matter, Citizen Power, Inc. ("Citizen Power") provides the following information:

I. Service List: Citizen Power respectfully requests that its entry on the service list should be for its counsel, as follows:

- II. Settlement: Citizen Power recognizes the potential savings for the Court and the Parties that can be achieved through settlement. Citizen Power is amenable to settlement discussions and the possibility of reaching a settlement in this matter.
- III. Schedule and Discovery Rules: Certain parties have been working together to develop a schedule for this proceeding prior to the Petition to Intervene of Citizen Power. Citizen

Power will work with the parties at the Prehearing Conference to develop a reasonable schedule

and any necessary modifications to the Commission's discovery rules.

IV. Witnesses: At this time, Citizen Power has not decided whether they will offer

testimony in this matter. If it is determined that Citizen Power will be calling a witness, the

Administrative Law Judges and other parties will be notified as soon as the witness is identified.

V. Issues: Citizen Power is in the process of reviewing the Application and Testimony

submitted by the Joint Applicants. From a broad perspective, Citizen Power is investigating

whether the proposed merger will produce net public benefits. More narrowly, Citizen Power has

determined that it has concerns regarding the impact of the proposed merger upon wholesale

markets and competition, the potential environmental effects of the proposed merger, and the

long term rate impacts for both FirstEnergy and Duquesne Light customers. At this time, Citizen

Power continues to evaluate its position on the Joint Applicant's Application and will refine its

position based upon further study of the plan, review of discovery and additional input from

other parties. Petitioner reserves the right to raise other issues as necessary and appropriate

during the course of the proceeding and to respond to issues raised by other parties.
